

CRM Online Marketing HTML & Email Tips

Purpose: The purpose of this document is to describe HTML & Email tips.

Tip	Description
Tags need for templates	<pre>Header:</pre>
Import HTML into an email	 Create the email document. Click the HTML tab or the Text tab, depending on the type of text you want to import. Click the Import HTML or Import Text button. Select the file you want to import and click OK.
Blacklist Checking	If you suspect you may be listed on a blacklist, use these tools to check: • Delivery Watch • MXToolBox • EmailReach • RepCheck • Blacklistedip
Email: Don't act like a Phisher	 Don't use an IP address as part of your email address. Use a valid domain name hosted on your server. Don't include HTML forms in email messages. Submitting and/or including forms in email messages is considered a security threat for many ISPs. Keep the HTML very light. Don't cross the Spam threshold with the number of HTML closing tags. Don't include JavaScript code in email messages. Don't include embedded objects in email messages, such as Flash or Active-X. Don't re-send rejected messages. Multiple SPAM indicators from an ISP can translate to blacklisting. Maintain compliance with CAN-SPAM Act



Tip	Description
Email Subject Line Suggestions	 Don't use colors. Don't use "gappy" text – e.g., F.R.E.E. Don't include links in the Subject line. Avoid suspicious subject lines. Aside from the obvious, web text words such as 'free', 'special offer', etc., should be avoided as much as possible, as should words in full caps and lots of exclamation marks - they're beloved of spammers.
Email Body Text Suggestions	 Avoid using all CAPS. Avoid using multiple exclamation points. Avoid using very large fonts. Avoid using red and yellow as font colors. Avoid using many different colors. Avoid using words or phrases associated with SPAM (e.g., free, buy, test). Consider using graphics to display words like 'FREE' if necessary. Avoid large graphics, or a high proportion of graphics to plain English text.
