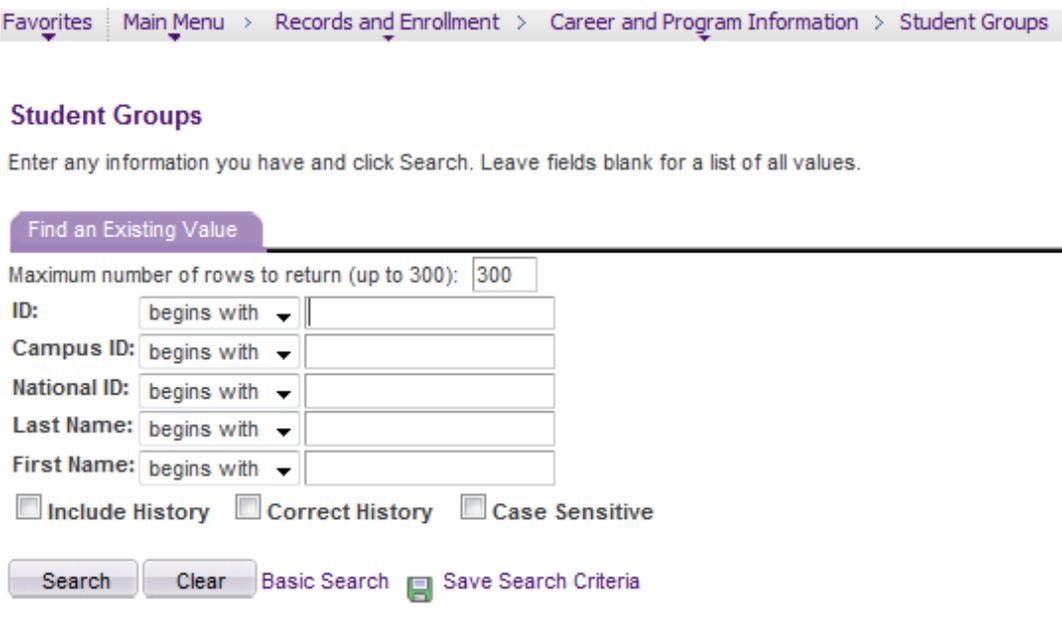
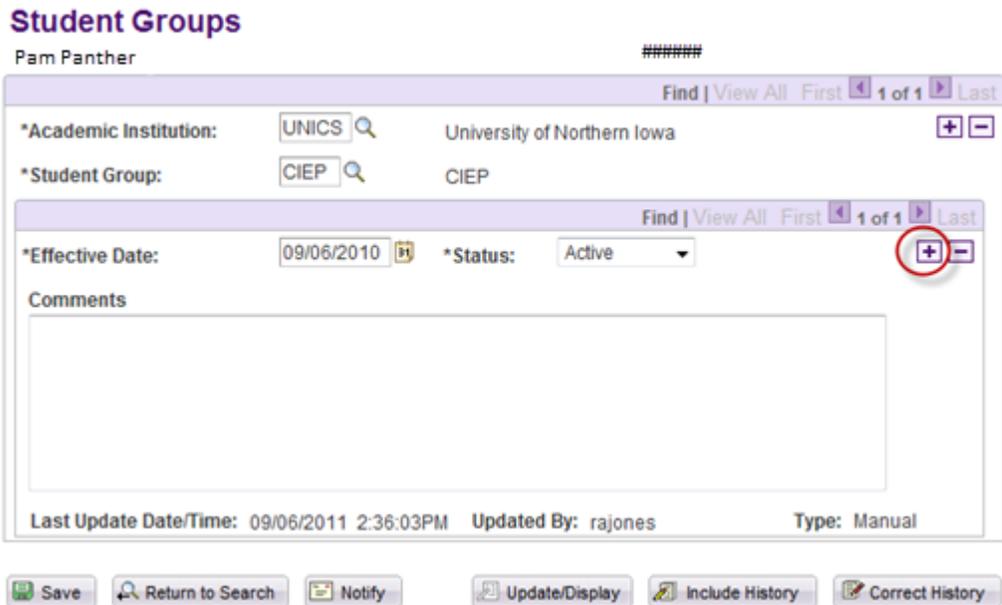
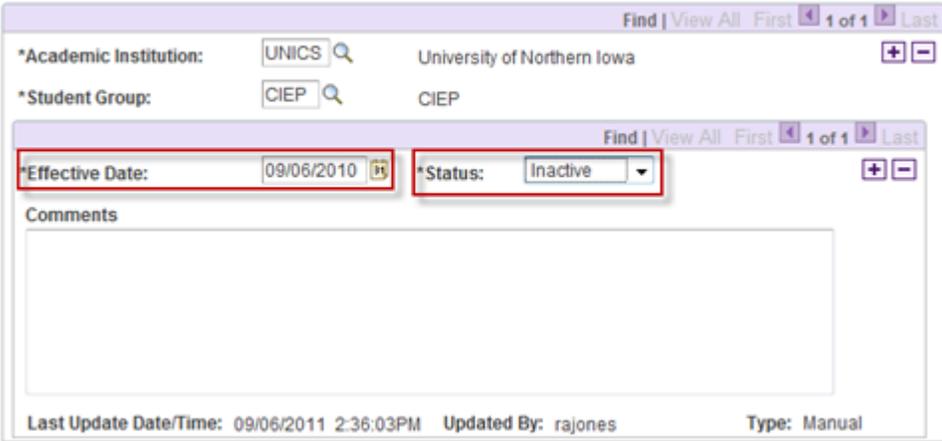


## Removing a Student from a Student Group

**Purpose:** Students may need to be removed (Inactivated) from Student Groups for various reasons. These instructions show how to inactivate a student from a student group (CIEP – Cultural and Intensive English Program) to indicate the student is no longer a CIEP student.

Step	Action
1.	<p>Navigate to the <b>Student Groups</b> page. Select <b>Main Menu &gt; Records and Enrollment &gt; Career and Program Information &gt; Student Groups</b></p> <p><i>Tip:</i> You may wish to add this page to your Favorites for easier access.</p> 
2.	<p>Enter <i>search criteria</i>. For example, enter the student’s six digit UNI ID in the ID field. Click the <b>Search</b> button.</p> <p><b>Result:</b> Student Groups page displays.</p>

Step	Action
3.	<p>On the <b>Student Groups</b> page, navigate to the student group you wish to remove (in this example, CIEP). Click the <b>Add Row</b>  button in the <i>Effective Date</i> area (NOTE: This is the lower <b>Add Row</b> button associated with this particular Student Group).</p>  <p>The screenshot shows the 'Student Groups' interface for Pam Panther.
