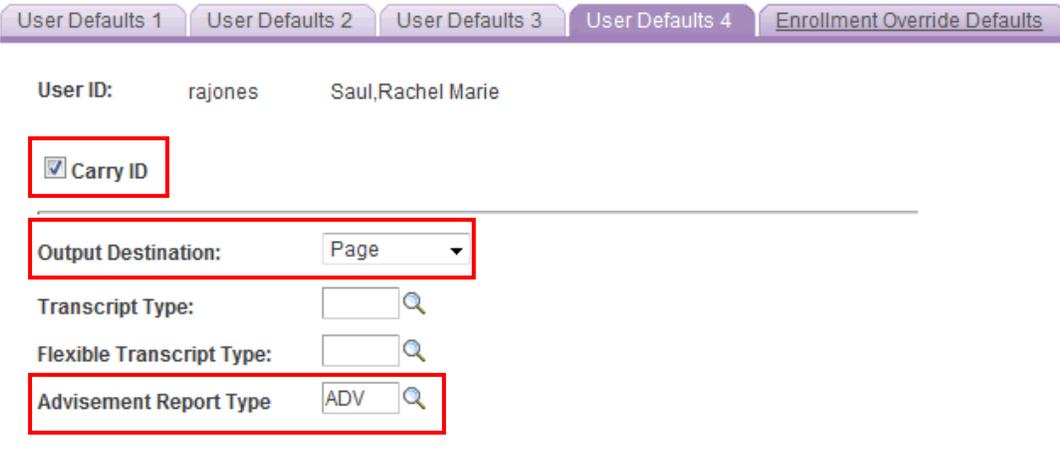
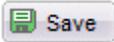
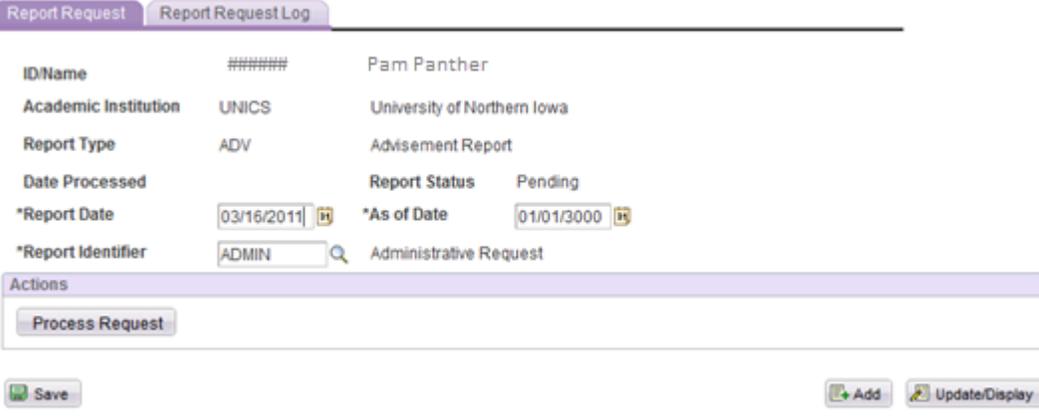


Request Advisement Report (Degree Audit)

Purpose: An **Advisement Report** (also known as a degree audit) is the data analysis that indicates whether a student has completed all of the requirements for graduation or if outstanding requirements must still be satisfied. The following instructions describe how to request an advisement report.

Step	Action
1.	<p>You must set user defaults prior to requesting advisement reports. Navigate to: Main Menu > Set Up SACR > User Defaults</p> <p>On <i>User Defaults 1</i> tab, set the Academic Institution field to <i>UNICS</i></p>  <p>On <i>User Defaults 2</i> tab, set the SetID field to <i>UNICS</i></p>  <p>On the <i>User Defaults 4</i> tab, check the Carry ID box, set the Output Destination field to <i>Page</i>, and set the Advisement Report Type field to <i>ADV</i></p>  <p>Click the Save button </p>
