






Searching for Classes

Purpose: Use the **Class Search** feature to search or browse for classes within a specific term. You may also search by class criteria such as course subject, course career, and course attribute. The *Additional Search Criteria* option contains many search parameters, including meeting start/end time, day of week, instructor, course title keyword, course component, etc.

Step	Action
1.	<p>Navigate to the Search for Classes - Enter Search Criteria page: Select Main Menu > Curriculum Management > Schedule of Classes > Class Search</p> 
2.	<p>Enter the appropriate search criteria. For this example, enter <i>Term = Fall 2011</i>, <i>Course Subject = Art History</i>, <i>Course Career = Undergraduate</i>. Click the Search button to display results.</p>

4.	Click the Start a New Search button. 
5.	Click the Additional Search Criteria option.
