





## Setting Browser Cache to Automatically Clear upon Exit

**Purpose:** When you use the Internet to access web pages, files, images and other downloaded content, your web browser caches, or stores, information on your computer. Sometimes this creates access issues and this information must be cleared to resolve the issue. You may clear your cache on an ad-hoc basis or you may adjust browser settings to clear the cache upon exiting the browser.

Browser	Action
<p><b>Mozilla Firefox</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Tools, Options</b> from the browser menu bar. <i>Note:</i> If you don't have the top navigation menu, use the <b>Firefox</b> icon  in the upper left corner</li> <li>• On the <b>Privacy</b> tab, set the <i>History</i> dropdown to: Firefox will: Never remember history</li> <li>• Click the <b>OK</b> button. Exit and relaunch browser.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Internet Explorer</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>From the menu bar at the top, select <b>Tools, Internet Options</b> <i>Note:</i> If you don't have the top navigation menu, use the <b>Tools</b> drop-down menu in the upper right corner OR right-click on the top window border and turn on the <i>Menu Bar</i></li> <li>On the <i>General</i> tab, in the <b>Browsing history</b> section, check the <i>Delete browsing history on exit</i> box.</li> <li>Click the <b>Apply</b> button. Click the <b>OK</b> button. Exit and relaunch browser.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Safari (for MAC)</b></p>	<p>A setting for clearing cache upon exiting Safari is not available; however these alternative options can be used:</p> <p><b><u>Adjust Safari Preferences for removing history</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Safari, Preferences</b> from the menu bar.</li> <li>• On the <b>General</b> tab, set the <i>Remove history items</i> field to: <b>After one day</b></li> </ul>  <p><b><u>Turn on Private Browsing</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Safari, Private Browsing</b> from the menu bar.</li> <li>• Click the <b>OK</b> button in the <i>Private Browsing</i> message box.</li> </ul>  <p>NOTE: Safari users may also select <b>Safari, Reset Safari</b>.</p>
