


Simulating FM Data & Making ISIR Corrections




Purpose: Financial Aid staff use the Institutional Needs Analysis System (INAS) Simulation functions as a work sheet to create different need analysis scenarios before committing the calculation for need analysis. The INAS Simulation process retrieves information from the **ISIR Correction** pages and **INAS Federal Extension** page.


Once you complete the changes in the Simulation, the system automatically creates a new ISIR in a separate effective-dated row. Access the ISIR to view and send the corrected information.

The following table describes how to simulate FM data, move the data into production, view and verify the data, and send the corrected data to the federal government.

Step	Action
1.	<p>Navigate to the Simulate FM INAS page. Select Main Menu > Financial Aid > Federal Application Data > Simulate 2010-2011 FM INAS</p> 
2.	Enter the appropriate search criteria.



Step	Action
3.	<p>Click the Search button.</p> <p>Result: The Student Income/Assets tab displays.</p> 
4.	<p>Use the various tabs to change student and/or parent income and asset values prior to INAS calculation. Click the Get Federal Data button. </p> <p>Result: The system copies the student's latest ISIR data to this page.</p>
5.	<p>Make any applicable changes. For example, update the <i>AGI</i> and <i>Student's Earnings</i> fields.</p>
6.	<p>Click the INAS button. </p> <p>Result: The Remote Function Call of the INAS calculation is invoked.</p>

Step	Action
7.	<p>Click the Use Simulated Data button.</p> <p>Result: The following prompt displays.</p> 
8.	<p>Click Yes to update the ISIR data. This moves the simulated data into production. The system automatically creates a separate effective-dated row for those ISIR changes.</p>
9.	<p>To verify and update the correction status, open up a new browser window and navigate to the FAFSA Information page in the ISIR Data Corrections component.</p> <p>Click the New Window link.</p> 
10.	<p>Select Main Menu > Financial Aid > Federal Application Data > Correct 2010 – 2011 IRIR records.</p>
11.	<p>Use the FAFSA Information page to verify the correction and to update the Correction Status field to Send.</p> <p>In the ISIR Data section, select Send in the <i>Correction Status</i> field.</p> 
12.	<p>If applicable, use the Assumptions\School Codes tab to enter corrections to a student's choice of school and housing, to override a student's dependency status, and to override FAFSA Assumption and/or Reject information on behalf of the student.</p> <p>Make any applicable changes.</p>
13.	<p>Click the Save button at the bottom of the page. </p> <p>Result: The corrected information has been flagged to send to the Federal Government.</p>
